

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Surgery and treatment summary:

The horse presented for evaluation due to symptoms of abdominal discomfort. Surgical intervention was pursued because of pain that was unresponsive to analgesia. The horse was placed in dorsal recumbency under general anaesthesia on the surgery table. A caecocolic intussusception was diagnosed during exploratory celiotomy. The intussusception was reduced with a combination of external pressure and a right ventral colon enterotomy to facilitate internal pressure. Once reduced, the caecum was noted to be oedematous however remained viable and did not require resection. The enterotomy was closed routinely. The large colon and abdominal cavity was copiously lavaged with sterile saline. Contamination was well controlled however an abdominal drain was placed at surgery to facilitate post operative lavage and drainage. The surgical incision was closed routinely and the horse recovered well from anaesthesia. In the post-operative period the horse continued to do well however developed a mild incisional infection. The horse was discharged to the care of the referring veterinarian, Dr. Mark Chitty for the remained of his treatment and rehabilitation.

Prognosis:

The prognosis for athleticism is excellent.
