This is the first foal for Jimmy Choux mare Addison. Racing out of the Lindsay Park Racing Stable, Addison won three of her 13 starts and was placed on a further three occasions including a third in the Listed Birthday Cup at Morphettville.

This colt was born in Australia and arrived at Trelawney at only a couple of months old once Addison was in foal to Exceed and Excel.

As a foal he was medium size with good bone and strength for a first foal. He has progressed nicely and now has real presence and quality.
