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This filly was born and raised at Trelawney Stud. She is just the second foal out of two-time winning mare Bhiwani who was trained by Roger James.

Bhiwani is the daughter of multiple Group performer Vedodara, making her a half to Group One winner Sharvasti and Group Three winners Bhandara and Shasatri.

Savabeel needs no introduction being one of New Zealand's most prolific sires to date.

As a foal this filly was very typical of a Savabeel filly – medium size, brown, strong and tough. She has now developed some scope and quality.

This is a current family and has numerous pedigree updates since the catalogue went to print including HK winner Tourbillon Diamond, stakes performer Tavidance and three additional Australian winners.
