CONSISTENT MEASURES

For a fair comparison of data

The most consistent and comparable Breeze Ups, with all two-year-olds breezing on the same turf track at Te Rapa Racecourse over two consecutive days.

To ensure the integrity of NZB's Ready to Run Sale, all horses have a blood sample taken immediately after breezing up.



EXTENDED VISION

Breeze Up and Parade Ring footage

All breeze ups are recorded in high definition from the home corner (around the 500m mark) to past the winning post.

Parade Ring vision of lots mounted pre-breeze up will also be taken to give buyers a 360 degree view of each horse at the Breeze Ups - from entering the mounting yard to galloping down the home straight.



DETAILED RECORDINGS

Independently verified for accuracy

Horses will be individually timed and may breeze up in pairs or on their own at the discretion of the consignor.

Various details will be recorded and independently verified including multiple timings for accuracy, pentrometer readings of the track each day and an outline of weather conditions for each breeze up.



ANALYSE & COMPARE

View clips and data online

All measurements including times, track conditions and weather can be easily viewed and compared from the NZB website, or downloaded within the Sale Info section.

All video clips including Breeze Up and Parade Ring footage, are available to view online just days after breeze ups, and can be downloaded or shared for further analysis.



2020 READY TO RUN SALE HIGHLIGHTS

The 2020 Ready to Run Sale aggregate reached \$17,639,500 while the average was \$95,349 and the clearance rate climbed to 77%. The median remained on par with 2020 at \$60,000 indicating a strong middle market.

New Zealand Bloodstock's 2020 Ready to Run Sale broke their own record in the final moments of Day Two, after Sam and Hana Beatson's Riversley Park offered Lot 298, purchased for \$700,000 in a bidding dual between Te Akau Racing's Jamie Richards and Kingsclere Stables' Roger James. The prolific cross between Savabeel and the O'Reilly mare Miss Opulence caught the attention of super stable Te Akau who managed to come out on top, securing the colt for a record price.

Sam Beatson's Riversley Park took out the 2020 Ready to Run leading vendor title for the fourth consecutive year, selling 23 horses for a total turnover of \$4,152,500.

The 2020 leading buyer by aggregate was Te Akau Principal David Ellis, having secured nine Lots for an aggregate of \$1,520,000.

The second highest priced lots were both secured for \$525,000 on Day One and Day Two in 2020. The top lot of Day One was purchased by Graham Richardson on behalf of a Hong Kong client in Lot 54, a Sacred Falls colt out of Savabeel Star for \$525,000 from Riversley Park. Trainer John Bell purchased the second top lot of Day Two, an Exceed and Excel colt (Lot 169) out of Chateau d'Yquem for \$525,000.

NZB's online bidding platform was implemented for the first time in 2020, working incredibly well and being responsible for more than 31% of the total turnover, with buyers spending \$5,441,000 remotely.

PROVEN HEAVYWEIGHTS



DARCI BRAHMA (NZ)
(Danehill x Grand Echezeaux)

The Oaks Stud stallion Darci Brahma is a prolific source of winners. He has delivered consistent quality throughout his stud career, finishing either second or third on the New Zealand premiership six times. His 694 runners have produced 505 winners, 53 of them at stakes level including Group One winners in New Zealand, Australia and Hong Kong. Classic stars such as **Catalyst** (NZ), **Risque** (NZ), **Artistic** (NZ), **Gust Of Wind** (NZ), **Kahma Lass** (NZ) and **Sierra Sue** (NZ) are notable examples, along with elite Hong Kong sprinter **D B Pin** (NZ).



PER INCANTO (USA)
(Street Cry x O'Really Baheeya)

Little Avondale Stud's Per Incanto is a stallion at the absolute peak of his powers. He topped last season's sire tables in Hong Kong for winners and wins, as well as finishing at the head of the New Zealand premiership by wins. His 415 runners to date have produced 270 winners, 22 of them at stakes level including Group One stars **Shadows Cast** (NZ), **Santa Monica** (NZ), **Dal Cielo** (NZ) and Bonham.



DEEP FIELD (AUS)
(Northern Meteor x Listen Here)

In the case of Newgate Farm's blistering sire Deep Field, the record speaks for itself. He has rapidly racked up 215 winners from just 334 runners to date including 12 high-speed blacktype winners. At the top of that list is **Portland Sky**, the winner of this year's Group One Oakleigh Plate (1100m) at Caulfield.



SAVABEEL (AUS)
(Zabeel x Savannah Success)

New Zealand's leading sire in each of the last seven seasons, Savabeel has been represented by more than 779 winners including 119 at stakes level. His 24 individual Group One winners include the current superstar mare **Probabeel** (NZ), high-flying Sydney four-year-old **Mo'unga** (NZ), last season's NZB Filly of the Year **Amarelinha** (NZ) and exciting young sire prospects such as **Cool Aza Beel** (NZ) and **Embellish** (NZ).



FRANKEL (GB)
(Galileo x Kind)

One of the world's all-time great racehorses, Frankel won all of his 14 starts - 10 of them at Group One level, and all of them with breathtaking ease. Frankel has carried on in a similar vein at stud, siring 359 winners from 541 runners with 81 individual blacktype winners including 20 at the highest level. That includes Australian impact with Group One winners **Hungry Heart**, **Mirage Dancer** and **Converge**. This year has seen Frankel reach an all-time high, topping British sires' standings with 13 stakes winners including the superstar three-year-olds **Adayar**, **Hurricane Lane** and **Snow Lantern**.



TAVISTOCK (NZ)
(Montjeu x Upstage)

Himself a multiple Group One winner over 1400 metres, the son of Montjeu has become a remarkable source of high-class classic horses. He has sired 401 winners from 600 runners, with 33 stakes winners including six at the elite level. **Tarzino** (NZ) and **Johnny Get Angry** (NZ) have both won the Victoria Derby (2500m) at Flemington, while **Tavago** (NZ) captured Randwick's Australian Derby (2400m).

EMERGING TALENT



CAPITALIST (AUS)
(Written Tycoon x Aiden Sea)

Himself a superb winner of the Group One Golden Slipper (1200m) and more than A\$3.5 million in stakes as a two-year-old, Newgate Farm stallion Capitalist made a similarly spectacular first impression with his maiden crop of juvenile progeny. Now commanding a service fee of A\$99,000, Capitalist has sired 33 winners from 94 runners, amassing over A\$4.9 million in stakes. His four stakes winners included Group One winner **Captivant**, while he was also represented by another seven blacktype placegetters including the Karaka Million 2YO (1200m) runner-up **Sneaky Shark**.



CONTRIBUTER (NZ)
(High Chaparral x Serisia)

Mapperley Stud's Contributor was a top-flight performer in his own right on the racetrack, reaching the pinnacle in his five-year-old season with Group One victories in the Chipping Norton Stakes (1600m) and Ranvet Stakes (2000m). So it was no surprise to see his first progeny come into their own at the age of three last season, stepping up to the big time with **Lion's Roar** (NZ) winning the Group One Randwick Guineas (1600m) and **Llanacord** (NZ) capturing the Group Two Lowland Stakes (2100m). Contributor finished the 2020-21 term as New Zealand's leading second-season sire.



PROISIR (AUS)
(Choisir x Prophet Jewel)

Rich Hill Stud's Proisir has hit headlines in recent seasons through the likes of the ultra-talented **Levante** (NZ), and his progeny overall number 79 winners from 142 runners to date with six individual black-type winners. Proisir is off to a superb start to the 2021-22 season with the Listed Wanganui Guineas (1340m) victory of Soldier Boy (NZ), while across the Tasman, Riodini (NZ) has finished second in the Group Two Chelmsford Stakes (1600m) and Group One George Main Stakes (1600m) in recent weeks.



ALMANZOR (FR)
(Wootton Bassett x Darkova)

Standing at Cambridge Stud, Almanzor is one of the best-credentialed stallions to shuttle to New Zealand in the last decade. Almanzor was Europe's champion three-year-old colt in 2016 and claimed the same honour in Ireland and France, and he received a Timeform rating of 133 and World Thoroughbred Rating of 129. His first New Zealand runner, **Gibraltar Rising** (NZ), also caught the eye in the opening two-year-old race of the season at Wanganui in September.



DERRYN (AUS)
(Hinchinbrook x Munhro)

Grangewilliam Stud's new recruit Derryn is by Hinchinbrook, sire of four Group One winners including superb Hong Kong sprinter Beat the Clock and Caulfield Guineas hero Press Statement. Derryn won three races, headed by the A\$600,000 Group Two Arrowfield 3YO Sprint (1200m) during The Championships at Randwick.



RIBCHESTER (GB)
(Ifraaj x Mujarah)

The winner of the Group One Prix Jacques le Marois (1600m), Lockinge Stakes (1600m), Queen Anne Stakes (1600m) and Prix du Moulin (1600m), Ribchester was Europe's Champion Older Male Miler in 2017. After initially shuttling to Australia in 2018 and 2019, Ribchester relocated across the Tasman and took up duties at Haunui Farm. His first crop of northern hemisphere two-year-olds has produced 15 winners from 59 runners, including three-race winner and Woodcote Stakes (1200m) runner-up **Flaming Rib**.



TIVACI (AUS)
(High Chaparral x Breccia)

In his final start before retiring to Waikato Stud, high-class racehorse Tivaci captured Group One glory in the All Aged Stakes (1400m) at Randwick. His 34 runners to date have produced 7 winners. Tivaci has already made his mark with his first crop of yearlings after **Never Been Kissed** (NZ) won last month's Group One Flight Stakes (1600m) for three-year-old fillies at Randwick.



TURN ME LOOSE (NZ)
(Ifraaj x Indomitable)

Turn Me Loose (NZ) is an exciting Group One-winning son of high-profile sire Ifraaj who stands at Windsor Park Stud. The sire of five individual winners to date, his oldest progeny are now three-year-olds headed by stakes winner **Turn The Ace** (NZ) who took out the Listed Waikato Equine Veterinary Centre 2YO Stakes (1100m) last season. Also by Turn Me Loose is exciting two-year-old **Wessex** who won the \$15,000 Transport Mechanical Waharoa Limited 1000.



VADAMOS (FR)
(Monsun x Celebre Vadala)

Rich Hill Stud's Vadamos is a son of the hugely influential Monsun, whose 113 stakes-winning progeny include three Melbourne Cup (3200m) winners. Vadamos started shuttling to New Zealand in 2017, and his oldest progeny are now three-year-olds - headed by the exciting filly **Art De Triomphe** (NZ), who won the Listed Canterbury Belle Stakes (1200m) and **Grace's Secret** (NZ) who won the Listed Welcome Stakes (1000m). Overall, Vadamos has sired 79 winners to date with three blacktype performers, including the Group Three York Acomb Stakes (1400m) runner-up **Spycatcher**.



SATONO ALADDIN (JPN)
(Deep Impact x Magic Storm)

An outstanding racehorse who won the Group One Yasuda Kinen (1600m) in a blistering time of 1:31.5, Satono Aladdin brought the sought-after bloodlines of Japanese titan Deep Impact to New Zealand when he started shuttling to Rich Hill Stud in 2018. He missed the 2020 season due to travel complications arising from COVID-19, but has made a welcome return to Rich Hill. His first Japanese runners have already yielded seven two-year-old winners this season, and his progeny in this part of the world have sold for up to \$360,000 at Karaka.



TIME TEST (NZ)
(Dubawj x Passage of Time)

Shuttling to Little Avondale Stud, Time Test is by Dubawi, who was a multiple Group One winner and was champion of his generation in Ireland at the age of both two and three. Time Test has sired 11 winners to date in his first juvenile crop, four of them at stakes level. **Romantic Time** won the Group Three Dick Poole Fillies' Stakes (1200m), **Rocchigiani** captured the Group Three Renate und Albrecht Woeste Zukunftsrennen (1400m), **Tardis** scored in the Listed St Hugh's Stakes (1000m) and **The King's Horses** won the Listed Rome Criterium Nazionale (1200m).



WAR DECREE (USA)
(War Front x Royal Decree)

War Decree has been an exciting new addition to the South Island's stallion ranks, standing at Inglewood Stud. From 11 starts, War Decree won three times including the Group Two Vintage Stakes (1400m) at Goodwood, beating the Dubai World Cup winner Thunder Snow. He also won the Group Three Dundalk Diamond Stakes (2300m) and placed in another two Group Two events.
