ACE HIGH (AUS)
(High Chaparral x Come Sunday)

Rich Hill Stud's Ace High is a son of Champion racehorse, superb sire and increasingly influential sire of sires High Chaparral, Ace High himself lined up in 28 races for five wins, four placings and more than A\$2.2 million in stakes. He completed an outstanding Gr.1 double in the spring of his three-year-old year, capturing the Spring Champion Stakes (2000m) at Randwick and Victoria Derby (2500m) at Flemington, and later added the Group Two Hill Stakes (2000m).



ALMANZOR (FR)
(Wootton Bassett x Darkova)

Standing at Cambridge Stud, Almanzor is one of the best-credentialed stallions to shuttle to New Zealand in the last decade. As Europe's Champion Three-Year-Old, Almanzor he made an immediate impact with his first crop as the Champion New Zealand Two-Year-Old Sire and Champion New Zealand First Season Sire for the 2021-22 season. At Ellerslie in January 2022, Almanzor became only the third first-season stallion in history to sire a Karaka Million 2YO (1200m) winner with his highly impressive son Dynastic (NZ).



BELARDO (IRE)
(Lope de Vega x Danaskaya)

Haunui Farm's Belardo was an elite racehorse, winning the Gr.1 Dewhurst Stakes (1400m) as a two-year-old. Belardo has made a strong start at stud in both hemispheres, siring 110 winners from 225 runners to date. He was also leading first-season sire in New Zealand in 2020-21, siring four winners in his debut two-year-old crop including Avonallo (NZ). He has sired a three further blacktype performers in New Zealand including Fellini (NZ). Belardo also produced three Gr-winning juvenile fillies in his first crop highlighted by Isabella Giles, Lullaby Moon and Verona.



EMBELLISH (NZ)
(Savabeel x Bling)

Cambridge Stud have included another Gr.1-winning blueblood in their talented sire line up. Embellish (NZ) is the first Gr.1-winning son of champion sire Savabeel to retire to stud, Embellish himself was offered by his breeders Waikato Stud at Karaka 2016, where Te Akau Racing's David Ellis secured him for \$775,000. He won three times in a 10-start career, headed by a superb victory in the Gr.1 New Zealand 2000 Guineas (1600m) at Riccarton.



EMINENT (IRE)
(Frankel x You'll be Mine)

A Gr.1 performer in both hemispheres in the famous colours of Pencarrow Stud, Eminent stands at Brighthill Farm in the Waikato. Eminent is a son of one of the world's greatest-ever racehorses, Frankel, who won all of his 14 starts including 10 at Gr.1 level. Eminent himself won three of his 13 starts including the Gr.2 Prix Guillaume (2000m) and Gr.3 Craven Stakes (1600m).



STAPHANOS (JPN)
(Deep Impact x Temple Spirit)

Novara Park's Staphanos is by the Japanese mega-sire Deep Impact, a world-class racehorse who has gone on to be champion sire in Japan on nine separate occasions. Staphanos raced from the age of two to seven, winning four of his 31 starts including the Gr.3 Saudi Arabia Royal Cup Fuji Stakes (1600m). He was also a five-time Gr.1 placegetter in the Queen Elizabeth II Cup (2000m), Hong Kong Cup (2000m), Osaka Hai (2000m) and two editions of the Tenno Sho Autumn (2000m).

EMERGING TALENT



TARZINO (IRE)
(Tavistock x Zarzino)

Westbury Stud's Tarzino has proven himself as a sire. The winner of the Gr.1 Rosehill Guineas (2000m) and the Gr.1 Victoria Derby (2500m) already sired 61 runners, including 21 winners. His progeny proved immensely successful in Australia with the champion Gypsy Goddess (NZ) winner of the Gr.1 Queensland Oaks (2200m), and second of the G1 Australian Oaks (2400m) as well as Jungle Magnate (NZ), who won the Gr.1 South Australian Derby (2500m) and the Gr.3 Chairman's S. (2000m).



THE AUTUMN SUN (AUS)
(Redoute's Choice x Azmiyna)

The spectacular star of his generation, The Autumn Sun is considered to be the one of the best raced colts by super sire Redoute's Choice. He was a five-time Gr.1 winner as a two and three-year-old highlighted by three Guineas victories. The Autumn Sun's pedigree represents the dedicated work of a far-sighted joint venture between the Aga Khan Studs & Arrowfield, bringing together the best of European female families and Australian sire-power to create a champion.



TIVACI (AUS)
(High Chaparral x Breccia)

Tivaci has sired 26 winners from his first crop and three from his second, with a pair of top-class stakes winners emerging this season. Three-year-old filly Never Been Kissed (NZ) won the Gr.1 Flight Stakes (1600m) and placed in the Group One Spring Champion Stakes (2000m), while the two-year-old Wolverine (NZ) began her career with three brilliant wins including the Gr.2 Wakefield Challenge Stakes (1100m) and Eclipse Stakes (1200m). She had her first taste of defeat when placing second in the 2022 \$1m DoubleTree by Hilton Karaka Million 2YO (1200m).



ALABAMA EXPRESS (AUS)
(Redoute's Choice x Lago Ovation)

The combination of two Australian stallion breedshapers in the sireline of Alabama Express makes him an exciting sire prospect. The sire of Alabama Express, Redoute's Choice, is an Australian phenomenon, peerless in his achievements at stud and continues to build his legacy through exceptional sons and daughters. Trained by Mike Moroney, Alabama Express faced some of the best horses in the country under a tough run at Caulfield when he took out the WFA Gr.1 C F Orr Stakes (1400m).



EXCEEDANCE (AUS)
(Exceed and Excel x Bonnie Mac)

Electrifying sprinter Exceedance was a standout in a stellar crop of three-year-old colts and possessed a sensational turn of foot and electric finish that made his final 600 metre sectionals hard to believe. As a winner of the time honoured Gr.1 Coolmore Stud Stakes (1200m) during the Flemington Spring Carnival, he joins an honour roll that features Zoustar, Merchant Navy, Sunlight, Brazen Beau, Sepoy, Star Witness, Alinghi and Northern Meteor. During the Spring he won the Gr.3 San Domenico Stakes over 1100m first up. He also scored placings in the Gr.2 Run To The Rose (1400m) and Gr.1 Golden Rose (1400m).



SUPER SETH (AUS)
(Dundeel x Salutations)

Super Seth is surrounded by spectacular stallion talent at his home of Waikato Stud, where he stands alongside the likes of Savabeel, Ocean Park and Tivaci. He is the first Gr.1 Caulfield Guineas (1600m) winner to stand at stud in New Zealand in three decades. From 12 starts, Super Seth won five races, headed by a brilliant Caulfield Guineas triumph over top-class rival Alligator Blood, who until that point had appeared unbeatable. He also won the Gr.3 Manfred Stakes (1200m) and HDF McNeil Stakes (1200m), and took on older horses with a gallant second placing in the Gr.1 Futurity Stakes (1400m) at Caulfield.



TURN ME LOOSE (NZ)
(Ifraaj x Indomitable)

A supremely talented racehorse, Turn Me Loose won the Group One New Zealand 2000 Guineas (1600m) and later added another two Group Ones in Melbourne in the Emirates Stakes (1600m) and Futurity Stakes (1600m). Now standing at Windsor Park Stud, Turn Me Loose has begun his stallion career with a hiss and a roar. He has sired 25 winners from his first crop and another three in his second, with five stakes winners headed by Lickety Split (NZ) in the Gr.1 Sistema Stakes (1200m) at Ellerslie and Prix De Turn (NZ) in the Gr.2 Alister Clark Stakes (2040m) at Moonee Valley.



US NAVY FLAG (USA)
(War Front x Misty for Me)

Elite sprinter U S Navy Flag, who now stands at The Oaks Stud, is by the globally influential War Front who has sired 107 stakes winners worldwide and is also making an impact as a sire of sires through the likes of Declaration Of War. From 19 starts, U S Navy Flag recorded five wins, beginning with a two-year-old Gr.1 double in the Middle Park Stakes (1200m) and Dewhurst Stakes (1400m). He backed that up as a three-year-old with the sire-making sprint, the Gr.1 July Cup (1200m), along with a placing in the Irish 2000 Guineas (1600m).



VADAMOS (FR)
(Monsun x Celebre Vadala)

The son of influential sire Monsun has wasted no time in making an impact at stud, siring 86 winners already from 206 runners worldwide. Vadamos' star New Zealand progeny include Gr.1 New Zealand Derby (2400m) runner up La Crique (NZ), who also won the Gr.2 Avondale Guineas (2100m) and Gr.3 Desert Gold Stakes (1600m) in the 2021-22 season. Along with fellow stakes-winning fillies Art De Triomphe (NZ) and Grace's Secret (NZ).



TEN SOVEREIGNS (AUS)
(No Nay Never x Seeking Solace)

Superb sprinter Ten Sovereigns made a huge impression on British racetracks as a two and three-year-old, scoring blistering victories in the Gr.1 Middle Park Stakes (1200m) and against an elite older field in the Gr.1 July Cup (1200m). He is by No Nay Never, who has rapidly become an enormously influential stallion in both hemispheres with 41 stakes winners including the likes of Alcohol Free, Brooke and the Kiwi star Need I Say More. Dam Seeking Solace placed at stakes level in France and is from the family of Gr.1 winner Shamal Wind (Dubawi).



TOO DARN HOT (GB)
(Dubawi x Da Re Mi)

Expectations were always going to be high for Dubawi's stellar son Too Darn Hot. He is a son of sire of sires Dubawi (Ire), out of the triple Gr.1-winning mare Dar Re Mi (GB) (Singspiel {Ire}), from the deep family of the prodigious sire Darshaan (GB). An undefeated champion at two who repeated as champion at three, Too Darn Hot won six of his nine starts including the Dewhurst Stakes (1400m), Prix Jean Prat (1400m) and Sussex Stakes (1600m) at Gr.1 level.



WYNDSPELLE (NZ)
(Ifraaj x Western Star)

Wyndspelle was a Gr.1 performer on both sides of the Tasman who raced with distinction at the ages of two, three, four, five and six. Himself a \$75,000 purchase from Karaka 2015 by bloodstock agent Phill Cataldo, Wyndspelle was quick to make his mark as a juvenile. A long line of elite placings followed in the Gr.1 Windsor Park Plate (1600m), Otaki-Maori WFA Classic (1600m), Tarzino Trophy (1400m) and two editions of the Thorndon Mile (1600m), but in late 2019 he finally broke through for a richly deserved win in the Gr.1 Captain Cook Stakes (1600m).
