CONSISTENT MEASURES

For a fair comparison of data

The most consistent and comparable Breeze Ups, with all two-year-olds breezing on the same turf track at Te Rapa Racecourse over two consecutive days.

To ensure the integrity of NZB's Ready to Run Sale, all horses have a blood sample taken immediately after breezing up.

DETAILED RECORDINGS

Independently verified for accuracy

Horses will be individually timed and may breeze up in pairs or on their own at the discretion of the vendor.

Various details will be recorded and independently verified including multiple timings for accuracy, penetrometer readings of the track each day and an outline of weather conditions including wind anenometer for each breeze up.

All breeze ups are recorded in high definition from the home corner (around the 500 metre mark) to past the winning post.







Horses

- Where practicable, maintain a recommended minimum safe distance of 5 metres from a horse
- Do not attempt to touch or inspect any horse without the permission and presence of the horse's handler
- Horses have right of way. Obey any instruction or request given by the handler of a horse moving through your vicinity. Don't position yourself where you create an impediment to or are blocking the movement of horses.
- The Sale ring, indoor parade ring, outdoor parade ring, ring entry and ring exit chutes
 are clearly defined by the post and rail fencing and rubber walking surface. These
 are non-pedestrian areas. Do not enter. There are defined areas where you can cross
 the chutes. Please ensure you check that there are no horses approaching and cross
 quickly.

Any person entering the complex does so at their own risk.

Follow instructions, obey all rules and signs posted about the complex. You must comply with instructions and directions given by staff or persons acting in an official capacity. If you are unsure, please do not continue and seek advice from a member of our staff.

Children under the age of 14 must be accompanied by a responsible adult at all times. No prams are allowed in the stable areas.

All visitors must park their vehicles in the designated car parking areas or where instructed to do so by persons acting in an official capacity. You must adhere to the complex speed limit of 20kph.

The complex is equipped with fire alarm systems. A CONTINUOUS sounding alarm indicates that you are to evacuate the building immediately by the nearest exit. Once outside the building, assemble with others at the assembly point situated on the lawn opposite the carpark in front of the Sale Day Office. Wait for instruction from the emergency warden. Do not try to re-enter the building until the All Clear has been given.

Fourths: While fourth placings in black type races may be mentioned in pedigrees, they do not qualify a horse for black type.

Jumping: Jump races now listed in the yellow section of the ICS book qualified for black type up and including December 31. 1985.

Designators: All group and listed designators are shown in bold type face where these were the official designation in the year of racing. Where races have been extrapolated back in time the designator is shown in light type face.

Local group races: For a small number of countries important to the Australasian breeding industry we have included local group race designators (Jpn-1, HK-1, Sgp-1). These designators are for information only and the races are recognised internationally as Listed only.





NZB'S CODE OF PRACTICE

New Zealand Bloodstock Limited ("NZB") has formulated a Code of Practice to benchmark a high standard of integrity and transparency in relation to bloodstock sales to safeguard the interests of vendors, buyers and other stakeholders.

For the purposes of this Code, the term:

- "Agent" means any employee or contractor of NZB, including auctioneers, authorised to act in the sale and/or purchase of bloodstock.
- "Client" means the person who has engaged NZB.
- "Customer" means the person to whom bloodstock is sold or from whom bloodstock is purchased on behalf of the Client.

This Code is subject to the Conditions of Sale.

- 1. The Agent shall make honesty and integrity the standard in all their dealings with Clients and Customers. The Agent will be clear in representing the business relationship between themselves and other involved parties.
- 2. The Agent shall not engage in any conduct which is misleading or deceptive or is likely to mislead or deceive.
- 3. The Agent shall not place himself/herself in a position where undisclosed personal interests conflict with those of NZB or the Client or the Customer.
- 4. The Agent shall act in the interest of their Clients and shall not bring disrepute to themselves or to NZB or the bloodstock industry.
- 5. NZB may act for more than one Client in a transaction, which may be the vendor and buyer, if this is disclosed by the Agent to the Client and no objection is raised.
- Under no circumstances will an Agent use his position to obtain a secret
 commission, profit or benefit. NZB and/or the Agent shall be responsible to the
 Client for any unauthorised commission, profit or benefit obtained by the Agent
 in the course of his/her employment.

NZB'S CODE OF PRACTICE

- 7. An auctioneer may bid as an Agent on behalf of a vendor on any lot on which a reserve price has been placed up to that reserve only if authorised by the Conditions of Sale
- 8. The Agent shall not bid or assist a person to bid on behalf of a vendor except as expressly authorised by the Conditions of Sale.
- The Agent must communicate to Clients or their representatives accurate details of all offers received for the Client's bloodstock as soon as practically possible.
- 10. The Agent shall ensure that all Clients' money is held to the account of the Client and must be properly accounted for.
- 11. The Agent shall ensure that all advertising shall meet the standard of fairness, decency, accuracy and honesty.
- 12. The Agent shall ensure that no bloodstock will be offered for sale without the Client having been given confirmation of commission and fees.
- 13. The Agent shall maintain the confidentiality of Client and Customer information.
- 14. The Agent shall not discriminate or deny equal professional services to any person by reason of race, creed, sex, marital status, disability or country of national origin.
- 15. The Agent shall keep up to date with and comply with all relevant contractual and commercial legislation. NZB submits to the jurisdiction of the New Zealand Courts for any alleged breach of relevant legislation.
- 16. The Board of NZB must ensure there is an appropriate internal process in place for resolving complaints which allege a breach of this Code. If appropriate the Board may initiate a disciplinary process in respect of an employee who is alleged to have breached this Code.
