In this multicultural City of Sails you will find a robust Pacific-Rim influence, culminating in an exciting blend of flavours combined with farm fresh ingredients. Mouth-watering sashimi at Masu, turmeric fried fish with rice noodle at Britomart's Café Hanoi, and The Blue Breeze Inn's delectable pork buns are just a few of the team at NZB's favourites.

VIADUCT

Fresh from a refurbishment, Soul Bar & Bistro is a constant on the NZB Dining Guide for its enviable location, great service, extensive wine list and delicious food. Harbourside offers views across the busy ferry terminal, best enjoyed over their market-fresh seafood platters. FISH at the Hilton, also recently renovated, offers fine seafood dishes amid a contemporary décor.

CBD

In addition to the restaurants named above there are a few more worthy of comment. The French Café is our handsdown winner for fine dining, located a short distance from The Langham Hotel. Meat Fish Wine in Chancery – a relative newcomer – has a dynamic, seasonally driven menu with one of the most impressive wine lists in Auckland. And finally, for a walk on the wild side try Cazador, a family run restaurant specialising in wild game and produce.
