On 10 August 2022 the above-described horse underwent arthroscopic surgery for removal of an osteochondritis dissecans (OCD) fragment from the distal intermediate ridge of the tibia in the left hock joint.

The joint was examined using the standard arthroscopic approach to the dorsal aspect of the tibio-tarsal joint. The fragment was identified and removed, and the remaining defect was debrided to reveal healthy subchondral bone. The joint was flushed with sterile saline and recovery from anaesthesia was uneventful.
