SURGICAL REPORT

Re: Sheezababe - Tivaci 2021 colt

On 16 March 2023 the above-described horse underwent arthroscopic surgery of the left stifle joint for treatment of an osteochondritis dissecans (OCD) lesion on the lateral trochlear ridge of the femur.

Right shoulder: 143 over 1

The joint was examined using the standard arthroscopic approach to the dorsal aspect of the femoro-patellar joint. The lesion consisted of several unattached osteochondral fragments overlying an irregular subchondral bone defect. The fragments were removed, and the remaining defect was debrided to expose healthy subchondral bone. The joint was flushed with sterile saline and recovery from anaesthesia was uneventful.

Management:

- 1. Rest: Please maintain on box rest for four weeks, followed by four weeks in a small yard before going back out into a small paddock.
- 2. Bute: Please give 10ml by mouth once daily starting tomorrow morning (18 March 2023) for another three days.
- 3. Antibiotics: Please give 33ml Depocillin intramuscularly morning and night (starting tonight) for another 2 days.
- 4. Suture removal: Please have your vet remove the sutures on Monday 27 March 2023.


Intravenous and intramuscular injections have been administered to this horse. Please monitor the catheter, injection sites, and incisions closely. Please contact your veterinarian if there are any signs of lameness, heat, pain, swelling and/or discharge.
